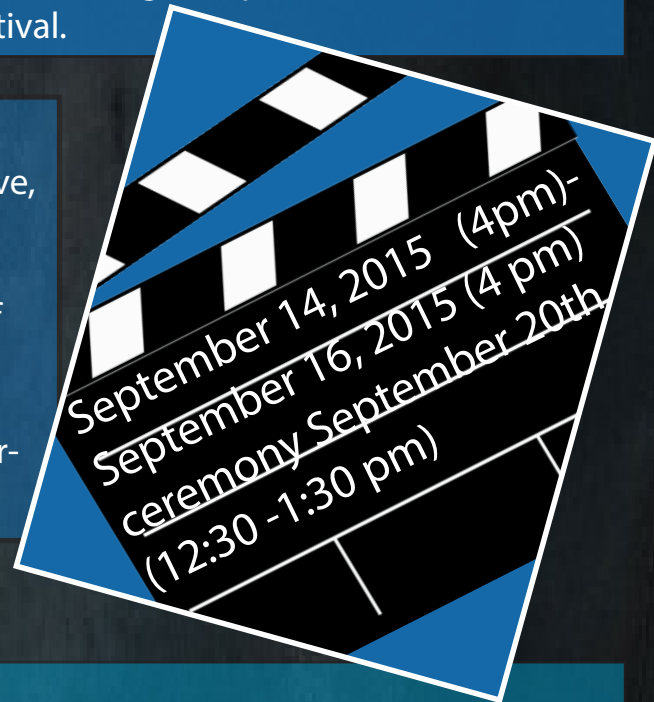


# 4 Reel 48-Hour Film Festival



A fun filled, fast paced weekend in which 25-year-old and under film makers write, shoot, edit and score a movie; all within a 48 hour time period. Hosted by the International Music Conference, the 4-Reel 48 Hour Film Festival will kick off with the assignment posted on the IMC website at 4PM on Monday, September 14, 2015. Each team will be assigned either a character, a prop, a line of dialogue, or a genre to include in their movie. 48 hours later, at 4PM on September 16 2015, the movie must be completed and turned into the judges. During an open screening, the judges will show the top five films and announce the winner at the closing banquet ceremonies of the IMC's 4-Reel 48 Hour Film Festival.

Inspired by the late Dennis Darrell, an independent film promoter who's mission was to keep independent films alive, the 4-Reel 48 Hour Film Festival is driven to give fledgling filmmakers an opportunity to showcase their talents. With his untimely passing, long time friends Bart Phillips, CEO of Sunseeker Media & Roger "Mook" Cassett, CEO of 2Dream Media, stepped in to keep Dennis' mission alive through creating the 4-Reel 48 Hour Film Festival as part of the International Music Conference.



## The Festival

Each group will register on the International Music Conference website. After registering, they will check back onto the site at 4 PM EST on September 14 to see the selected assignment. They will then have 48 hours to complete their project and turn it in to the Sunseeker Media office. All participants are highly recommend to attend the panels and sessions of the International Music Conference where they can learn more about the music industry and their craft. At the closing ceremony on Sunday September 20, the top five films will be presented with judges present. The winner will be announced and awarded a \$6,000 Canon camera and lense.

One member of each participating team will attend a viewing ceremony on Sunday, September 20, 2015 at the grand Civil and Human Rights Center at 12:30 PM - 1:30 PM. The top five films will be presented and judges will voice out their opinions about each film. Film festival participants will receive their USB submissions at this event. The winning film will be announced at the end and the prize handed to the winner.
